A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR MARK

Hi friends,

Happy New Year to each of you! I hope and pray that 2026 will be a year of blessing, joy, peace, and favor for you and your family.

As I reflect on the year that just ended, I am amazed by how much God has blessed Freedom Church International in the past year. We began 2025 with new campuses of Freedom Church being launched in Agenebode and Benin City in Edo state, Nigeria. Now, one year later, both of those churches have land, water wells, and new church buildings... and each campus is running over 200 people in their Sunday attendance!

Our Lagos 2 church was told by the landlord in early 2025 that they would need to give up their building in the coming months. God has provided land in a good location (so rare!) for the Lagos 2 campus, and a water well has been dug. By late January, a new church building should be completed there. That is three pieces of property acquired, three new water wells dug, and three new buildings built in 2025. Only God could do that.

Now as we begin 2026, two new campuses of Freedom Church International have just been officially inaugurated. A satellite of our Lagos 1 campus has been meeting in rented space and is now running 75-80 people on Sundays. We are now officially launching this as our Lagos 3 campus. And in Kogi state, about an hour north of our Idah campuses, a new group of Freedom Church pioneers, on December 7th, began meeting in the Itobe (ee-toe-bay) community in a borrowed school facility. This brings us to a current total of nine Freedom Church International campuses in Nigeria, plus the home campus in Fairhope. **In exactly five and a half years, God has grown our little church in Fairhope, Alabama from one campus and congregation to a total of TEN campuses and thriving congregations!!** God has done this. But it has been your prayers, your faith, and your generous gifts which have made this possible. So, thank you for believing God and doing your part.

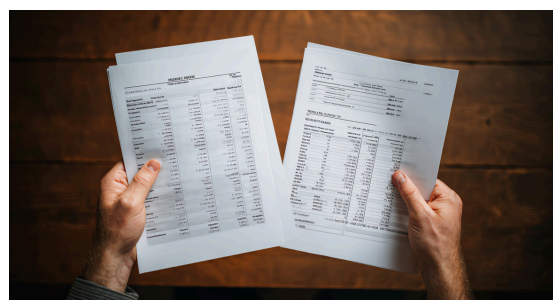
We hope you will join us on **Thursday nights from 6:15-8:30 pm** in the Grace Room. *Dinner and childcare are provided.*

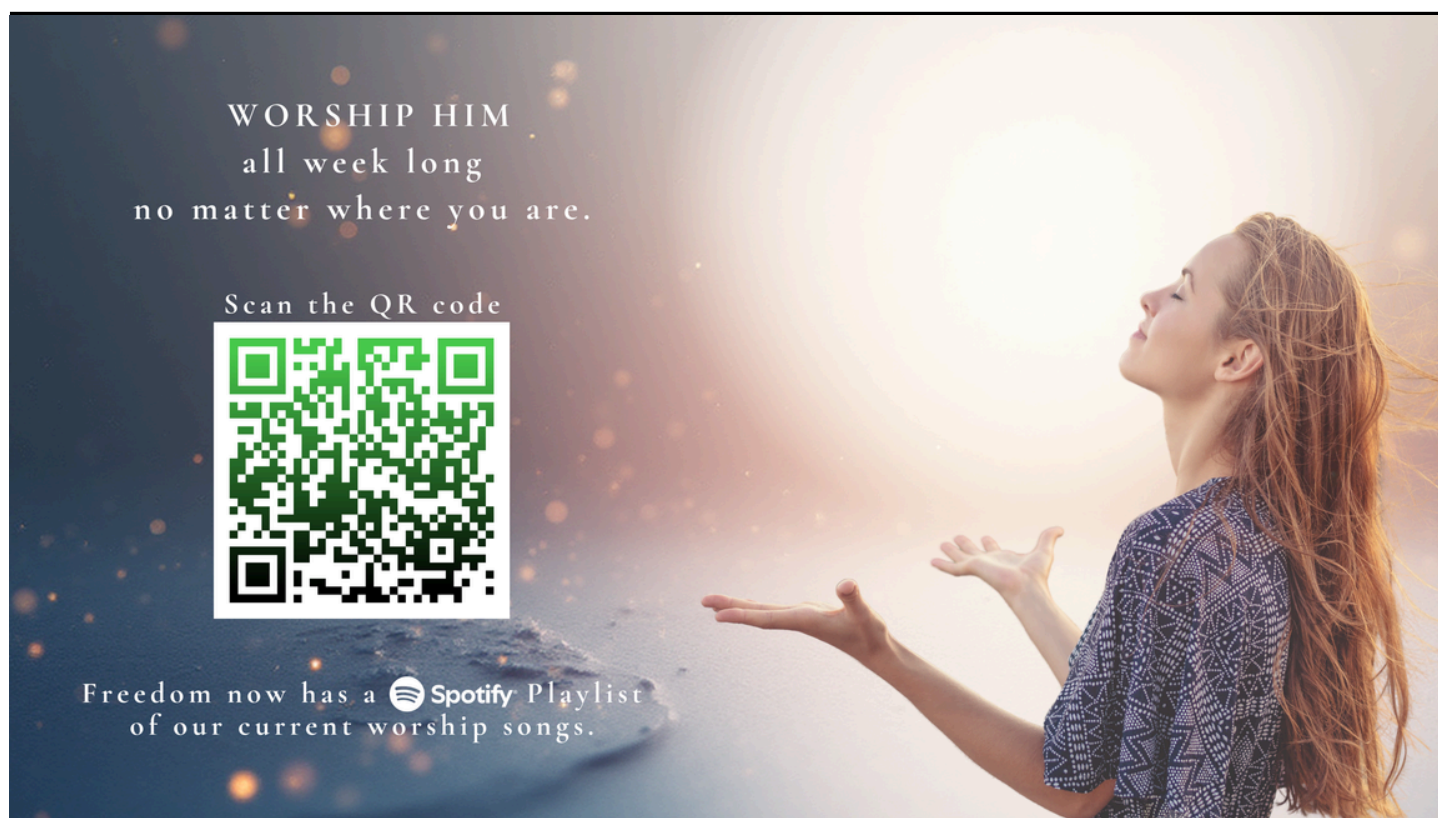

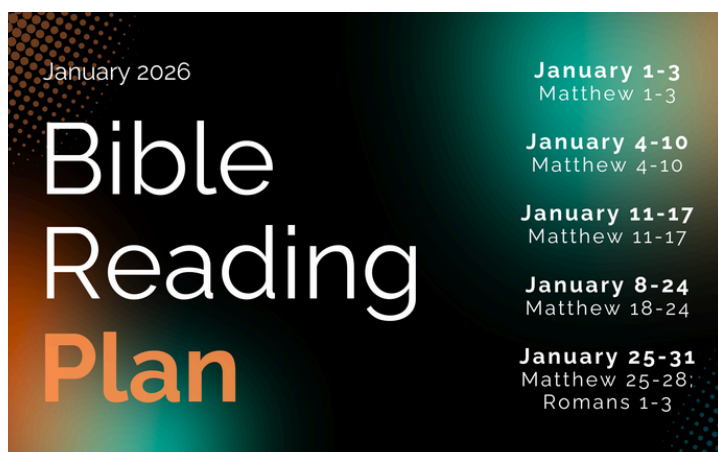
