A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR MARK

Hi friends.

As you likely know, we are in a month-long season of prayer for our ongoing church-planting efforts in Nigeria and also for how each of us can be involved in supporting this mission. We have three goals that we are pursuing in Nigeria as we go into the fall.

First, we want to finish and furnish the new church buildings at our two newest Freedom Church International campuses in Edo state (Agenebode and Benin City). The buildings are near completion, so the primary task will be to furnish them and to have water wells and cistern systems installed on each campus to provide clean water for both the church and people in the community. The cost to do these things is approximately \$15,000,



Second, we have an urgent need to construct a church building at our Lagos 2 campus where the church has been meeting in rented space for more than two years. The landlord wants the building back, so we need to very quickly put a new facility in place for this young, growing congregation. Land has already been purchased, so now we need to construct a new building and install a water well system. The cost for this project will be at least \$45,000.

And third, we want to financially bless our sister church in Nigeria, God's Standard Bible Church, which is led by our own Pastor Isaiah and Mama K. God's Standard graciously spent \$120,000 this year to purchase the three pieces of property in Edo and Lagos states and has paid for construction of two new building at our two newest campus sites in Edo state. We want to bless them in return! That is why we have committed to give God's Standard Bible Church half of all the money that we raise in September and over the next 12 months in our Nigeria capital campaign.

We are praying toward a miraculous outpouring of generosity on **September 14**th, our **Commitment Sunday**. Our goal is that \$120,000 will be raised in the form of one-time, above-the-tithe gifts and 12-month commitments so that we can accomplish all that is described above. That is a HUGE God-size goal, but I believe that we will see it happen by God's grace!

A CALL TO SERVE


Helping Families in Need
