A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR MARK

Hi friends,

I am so grateful to God for you. In August, I asked you to begin praying for our three capital improvement projects in Nigeria and how you can help support that. And on September 14th, we opened the door for everyone to make a commitment to pray and/or give toward our goal of \$120,000. On Sunday, October 5th, I will share the results of what has been given and committed. If you have not yet made a commitment or given a financial gift and would like to do so, you can bring those with you on October 5th, or you may give them online.



The one word that God continues to keep ringing in my ears is the word BLESS. "Be a blessing every day to someone in your path. Bless them with your prayers. Bless them with your time and attention. Bless them at the table. Bless them with your story and with the gospel. Lead Freedom Church to bless the people of Baldwin County and of Nigeria." God has blessed us to be a blessing to others. This is a theme that I hope will never die at Freedom.

As I shared in the month of September, the word BLESS has a very specific meaning as we seek to follow Jesus' example of how He befriended and blessed people every day. For us, that example can be spelled out with the letters B-L-E-S-S, as follows:

- B Begin with prayer
- L Listen to people
- E Eat with people every week
- S Serve others
- S Share your Story and His Story (the gospel)

I want to encourage you to create a "hot list" of lost and unchurched people to pray for every day. I have seven such friends that I pray for each day. Seek to make connections with them, to check on them, and listen

to them. Be intentional about your meals. Make a point to share meals with people from outside your home each week. Also, look for small and big ways to make their lives easier by serving them. As you pay the "relational rent" necessary to build trust, watch for the opportunities God will provide for you to share the story of what Jesus has done in your life and to share the gospel.

As we practice these things on a daily and weekly basis, they will become habits; and as we share our stories with each other of how God is allowing us to impact the lives of people around us, a *culture of BLESSing* will grow and thrive here at Freedom Church. May God use us together to bless our families, neighbors, friends, co-workers, and the world!

FALL FESTIVAL


Sunday, October 26th at 4:30 pm
