A message from... Our Pagtor

August is always a very important month at Freedom Church, and that will be the case again this year. Throughout the first three weeks of August, you will have an opportunity during Sunday morning worship to sign up to participate in an adult small group this fall. Our small groups meet on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, and our ladies-only small groups



meet on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. These groups truly comprise "the other half" of belonging to Freedom Church. Sunday morning worship is great, but we have not fully connected to the church until we take the step of connecting to a small group.

Our small groups meet weekly for two hours at a time. The meeting times are divided into three roughly equal parts. The first third of the meeting is a very unstructured time of eating and talking together. The middle third of the meeting is a more structured share and prayer time. And the final third of the meeting is a very discussion-oriented time of Bible study related to the sermon from the previous Sunday.

I can say from more than 25 years of experience in these kinds of groups that the small group experience is where we transition from "going to a church" to "belonging to a church family." This is where walls come down and deep relationships develop. I hope that you will make plans to participate in a small group this fall. Please take a minute to fill out a small group sign-up card (located in the seatbacks in the worship room) and drop it in the offering plate during worship. Our small group meetings will begin the week of August 17th.

On that same day, we will celebrate Freedom Church's 13th anniversary! That day will also be Vision Sunday at Freedom. I hope that you can join us as we recall and celebrate what God has done over the past 13 years and as we consider what He is calling us to do in the months and years ahead.
