Delta State, Nigeria

Established in 2020 by overseers Isaiah Kadiri and Mama K (Christiana), this was the first campus planted in Nigeria. It is located in a city with a population of 250,000. This campus serves as a training ground for new pastors of future church plants.

Kogi State, Nigeria

Established in 2021, this campus is located in Idah, a city with a mixed population of 115,000, with more Muslims here than in Delta State.

Kogi State, Nigeria

Established in 2021, this campus was a spontaneous offshoot of the Idah 1 campus, starting in a school building. It is our fastest growing campus.

Kogi State, Nigeria

Established in 2025, this campus is located in the Okenya community and is across the street from a university.

Lagos 1

Lagos State, Nigeria

Established in 2023, this campus is located in Lagos, a city of 25 million people (having the largest black population on earth).

Facility: Land, water well; currently meeting in rented space

Lagos 2

Lagos State, Nigeria

Established in 2023, this growing campus now meets in a beautiful new facility while continuing to expand its ministry and outreach.

Facility: Land, building, water well

Lagos 3

Lagos State, Nigeria

Established in 2024, this campus originally started as a satellite campus of Lagos 1 before becoming an independent congregation.

Facility: Rented space

Benin City

Edo State, Nigeria

Established in 2024, this campus is located in Benin City, which has a population of 1.8 million people and is considered the informal center of idolatry in Nigeria.

Edo State, Nigeria

Established in 2024, this campus is located in a Muslim community of 90,000 people. Our campus pastor is having to learn a new language to minister to people in this area.

Itobe

Kogi State, Nigeria

Established in 2025, this is one of the most recent campuses planted. Itobe has a population of 120,000 people.
